The Lord has revealed to us enough truth in His Word basically
to cover **any of the issues of life!**

Last week: **“Stop worrying!” – Jesus in Matthew 6**

The world can be a difficult place.

- **Isaiah 8:21-22**
- **Ecclesiastes 2:17,23**
- **John 16:33**

The word in the Greek there for trouble is actually “pressure.”

God is in the trouble.

- **Isaiah 14:24**
- **Isaiah 46:10,11**
- **Amos 3:6-7**

In ancient history recorded in the Word of God, when God brought about a calamity, it was inevitably a judgment, and that judgment had a warning, and the warning would always come from God to the prophets.

God will declare His right ***as a just and holy God*** to judge sin and injustice; and when judgment comes, God takes full responsibility for it.

The question is not, “Why does God allow these things to happen?” The question is, ***“Why doesn’t God allow them to happen more often or even more fatally?”***

Lamentations 3:37-39

Isaiah 45:15

There are some things God wants you to know:

1. That He works all things according to His will.

Ephesians 1:11, Romans 8:28

2. That if you belong to Him, it's all working together for your good.

3. That in the end, it is all for His glory.

“For from Him and through Him and to Him are ALL THINGS,” Romans 11:36

God wants us to know this: “You’re Mine. I love you. I sent My Son to die for you. You are My child. Trust Me. Trust Me.”

God is in charge of everything. He’s not revealing everything, but He is doing something, and that is.....
