



## New Hampshire Community Church Re-Start Plan May 17, 2020

NHCC will resume regular public worship services starting Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 under the following board-approved parameters:

- ***Unlocking the Bible*** Bible Study (9:00am Sunday School) will not resume and will re-start at a later date.
- No Children's Church, no nursery.
- No coffee or refreshments available in kitchen, but feel free to bring your own 😊.
- Pew bibles will be removed from the pews.
- Every other row of pews/chairs will be closed off – families/members of the same household can sit together, otherwise **“social distance” at 6-feet at all times from other people.**
- No greeters or bulletins. NHCC volunteer staff member will be posted at each entrance door to open the doors for people as they enter church.
- Hand sanitizers available at entrances.
- Baskets for offerings located at the entrances (no passing of collection baskets during service).
- A sign at each entrance – “No Contact (Hugs or Handshakes) Greetings, Please”
- Use of masks or face coverings are **recommended** but not required.
- It is suggested that elderly stay home, those not feeling well stay home, those exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms stay home (and call your doctor).
- We will continue live-streaming the Sunday 10:30am worship service via Facebook Live.
- The church will have all high touch/common touch surfaces disinfected and “fogger” used for disinfecting church after each Sunday worship service.

**The church has been prepared for worship and we will use common sense to protect our health and safety! These parameters and guidelines will remain in place until changed by the NHCC Board of Directors.**
